**Intro:** { G A C D } X 4 (Bass comes in 3rd time) D

**Verse 1:** { G A C D } X 4

If you should love me, I'll take it in stride  
If you should go on down to hell, I'll come along for the ride

**Chorus:** G B7 C — C/B -- C/Bb A

C -- Cadd9 — C -- Cadd9  
And I wish I was dead like I wish you were mine  
Dadd9 -- D — Dadd9 -- D

**repeat the previous 4 lines of chords**

Get me out of my life now before it's too soon  
I just know I'll wake up, and the nightmare will end  
And I'll find someone else and start at it again

**Loud Transition:** { G A C D } X 4 D

**Verse 2 = Verse 1**
